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Where does Botswana get its power?

To meet its peak power demand, Botswana imports power from the Southern Africa Power Pool (SAPP) - mainly from South Africa - and when imports are not available, resorts to the use of costly backup diesel power plants.

How will Botswana Power Projects be implemented?

These projects, with a combined capacity of 1.5GW, will be implemented through private sector investment, with the Botswana Power Corporation (BPC) acting as the offtaker under long-term Power Purchase Agreements (PPAs) of up to 25 years.

Does Botswana have a potential for concentrating solar power?

Botswana has a relatively huge CSP potential capable of exceeding the current peak energy demand by an order of a magnitude. A bottom-up approach that takes into account solar energy availability and land resource constraints is used to assess the technical potential for concentrating solar power (CSP) in Botswana.

What is the power sector in Botswana?

Revised in April 2025, this map provides a detailed view of the power sector in Botswana. The locations of power generation facilities that are operating, under construction or planned are shown by type - including liquid fuels, gas and liquid fuels, coal, hybrid, hydroelectricity and solar.

The Botswana map shows that the best areas for high solar insolation lie in the western and northern parts of the country, particularly in the Ghanzi and Maun areas.
